SPRING REGISTRATION STARTS ON MONDAY!



LES will be conducting a weeklong registration during 30 Mar-3 Apr. Please note that registration is required for all returning students. We will also accept registration packets for new kindergarten students. **Please remember new kindergarten students must be 5 on or before 1 Sep to qualify.** See below for dates, times, and locations.

31 Mar – Liberty Intermediate School, RAF Lakenheath (0900-1500)

1 Apr – Bob Hope Community Center, RAF Mildenhall (0900-1500)

2-3 Apr – Lakenheath Elementary School (0830-1530)

The sponsor or the sponsor's spouse must sign the registration forms. Please bring in a current copy of your orders and your child's immunization records. If your DEROS date has changed, then we will also need a copy of your DEROS extension or any other official documentation to support the new DEROS date. Birth certificates for all new registering kindergarten students are required.
